In creating the refresh model, Henley’s premier hardcore fishing vessel and the original Bahama DNA remain completely intact. 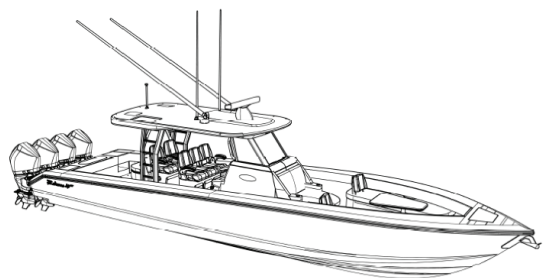
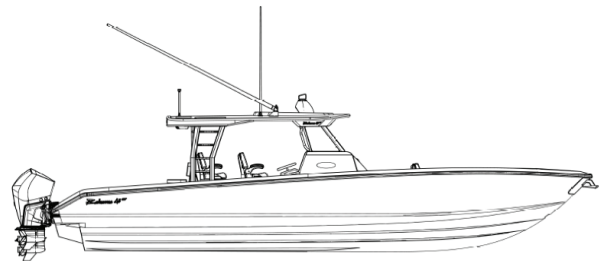
